A.1108/S04704 - require posting meeting minutes/transcripts, within two weeks of a meeting.
A.1228/S01150 - requires (1) meeting documents to be made available at least 24 hours prior to the public body meeting; (2) meeting must be streamed on public body's website (to the extent practicable); (3) video of meeting must be posted on website within 5 business days of the meeting; and (4) public body must maintain recording for at least 5 years. Senator Kaplan is sponsoring this bill in the Senate.
A.4677/S4863. Kaplan filed the Same in the Senate, S.4863. - The intent of this bill is to eliminate the fee agencies charge individuals for obtaining records through a FOIL when an electronic copy already exists.
