A.1108A/S04704A - require posting meeting minutes/transcripts, within two weeks of a meeting.

A.1228/S01150 - requires meeting documents to be made available at least 24 hours prior to the public body meeting.

Both bills have passed the Assembly & Senate and will be forwarded to the Governor for signature.

McMahon – A08071/S06958- Allows public bodies to conduct meetings via video as long as the public is given opportunities to view such video live. A video recording of the meeting must be posted on the public bodies website within 5 business days. The public body must also make available a specific location for the public to view and listen to the meeting if requested at least 48 hours prior to the meeting.

This bill has the support of the NY State Conference of Mayors.

Paulin A6863 – Amends the Open Meetings Law to allow for public comment in real time from a remote location when a public comment period exists during a meeting.
